The Puppy Kindergarten class is a building block for pawrents hoping to have a well-mannered dog once their pup gets older. Giving your dog structure with basic obedience commands is a great tool to help with their success - and we want nothing but the best for our fur babies!

During the week (M-F) your dog will get 1-2 hours of training a day, participate in daycare each day, and get a bath and nail trim towards the end of the week. There is also a boarding night included in the class, so pups can practice being kenneled away from home. They will go home with a daily report card, going over what they did that day.

Once the week is completed you will have a "graduation" meeting with Callie and go over everything your pup learned during the week. The meeting may or may not be with the other doggos in that week's class. Your pup will also receive a certificate.

MONDAY

- ▶ Sit
- ▶ Name recognition
- ▶ Down (lay down)

TUESDAY

- ▶ Come (recall)
- ▶ Off (no jumping up)
- ▶ Stay

WEDNESDAY

- ▶ Monday and Tuesday review
- ▶ Place (staying in a down position on a cot)

THURSDAY

- ▶ M, Tu, W review
- ▶ Leave it
- ▶ Bath and nail trim

FRIDAY

- ▶ Weeks review
- ▶ Bath and nail trim

STONEHILL KENNEL GROUP CLASSES

All five (5) group classes are geared towards creating a healthy relationship between you and your dog, and between your dog and other dogs. Our hope is that we can create a foundation for you and your dog that can eventually lead to a canine good citizen title and/or trick dog title, if you so desire. If that is not your goal, then we hope to create a positive relationship between you and your dog, and just so that you can simply enjoy your dog!

We will use training tools such as slip leash or martingale collar, head collar, clicker, long lines, and treats! **Price of day class includes a slip leash that you can use at home.** We will modify our training practices to best fit your dog's learning style, with an emphasis on the two following quadrants of conditioning: positive reinforcement (adding a reward when they do something right) and negative punishment (taking away a reward when they do something negative).

ADULT CLASS - BASIC OBEDIENCE \$150

Learn/practice the following commands:

- ▶ Sit (stay)
- ▶ Down (stay)
- ▶ Place
- ▶ Basic recall
- ▶ Heel (leash manners)
- ▶ Off
- ▶ Proper play interactions
- ▶ Remaining calm around other dogs, people and distractions

PUPPY CLASSES \$150

For dogs under 6 months of age.

- ▶ Includes all skills covered in adult group classes plus:
 - ▶ Body handling
 - ▶ Crate training
 - ▶ And emphasis on positive interactions between puppies

ADULT CLASS - INTERMEDIATE OBEDIENCE \$200

Dogs must have either gone through Basic Obedience classes, or complete a brief test on performance of commands covered in our basic obedience class.

- ▶ Both the Canine Good Citizen and the Trick Dog Title tests do not allow you to use treats or toys as a lure, and the CGC doesn't allow either at all. Therefore, we will begin to fade out the use of treats, instead focusing on keeping your dog's attention on you.
- ▶ Practicing all commands OFF-LEASH
- ▶ Beginning trick dog exercises, here are some examples of tricks we can cover:
 - ▶ Shake
 - ▶ Spin
 - ▶ Jump/over
 - ▶ Get your ___ (retrieve)
 - ▶ High five
 - ▶ Dance
 - ▶ Paws up (2 feet)
 - ▶ Push ups
 - ▶ Touch/target
